



MOT Demonstration Test Changes 2021

The below outlines changes to the MOT 2021 Annual Assessment as provided from the DVSA.

Q: Can I still carry out a DVSA VT8 demonstration test without the use of an assistant if an automated lane is available?

A: The use of an assistant was relaxed as part of the COVID restrictions. This was only a temporary measure and now COVID measures have eased, trainers should now ensure that learners are aware of the two-person test procedure.

Q: Will I be asked any questions regarding my mechanical knowledge when carrying out my DVSA VT8 demonstration test?

A: Once the demonstration test is complete, the vehicle examiner conducting the test may ask the candidate questions relating to their understanding of mechanical systems on the vehicle being tested.

Q: Can I use e-Learning as part of the delivery of Level 2/3 MOT qualifications?

A: The DVSA will **NOT** accept any part of these qualifications being delivered via e-Learning or remote platforms. All content **MUST** be delivered face to face.
