Level 3 Apprenticeship Framework Vehicle Fitting

The content of this framework has been agreed between the Department for Employment & Learning and The Institute of the Motor Industry (IMI). This is the only Level 3 training in this skill acceptable for the receipt of ApprenticeshipsNI funding.

1.0 GENERAL

This framework specifies the standards and the criteria for the delivery of a Level 3 Apprenticeship framework to achieve qualified status within the Automotive Retail Industry. Successful completion of the framework will lead to the award of a VCQ Qualification at Level 3, VRQ qualification at Level 3, Essential Skills Certificate(s) and recognition as a qualified person within the industry sector.

2.0 PROVISION CONTENT

The Provision shall comprise of four main elements to be delivered in an integrated manner, not isolated subjects. Achievement of the VCQ qualification at Level 3 and the relevant VRQ qualification at Level 3 will be demonstrated by possession of Awarding Organisation certificates.
