



The Bill will:





Charging **Points**

Provision for the installation of charging points for both electric and hydrogen vehicles



Framework

Allowing the regulatory framework to keep pace with the fast evolving technology for electric cars, helping improve air quality



Extend Compulsory

Motor Insurance

Cover the use of automated vehicles, to ensure that compensation claims continue to be paid quickly, fairly & easily, in line with longstanding insurance practice





WHAT IS IT?

In April 2017 the Apprenticeship Levy was introduced to UK employers

£3M+ PAY = 0.5% LEVY

It is expected to bring in c£2.5bn per annum for Apprenticeship Training and Assessment

Managed by HMRC

Employers directly funding Apprenticeship Training and Assessment for "new starts" from May 2017

WHAT'S CHANGING?

Governments plan is to give employers more involvement and choice in Apprenticeship Training

Employer-led steering groups are developing new Apprenticeship standards and assessment plans, replacing the current Apprenticeship Qualifications and Frameworks (England Only)



Apprenticeship Standards

WHAT'S CHANGING?

Employers will take greater accountability in the Apprentice journey, with specific mentor responsibilities in the workplace, rather than Assessors from Training Providers

Achievement is reliant on passing an end point assessment





- Careers advice for students






