

# Level 3 Apprenticeship Framework

## Vehicle Fitting Operations

Framework No. 383 Issue 5: 06/17

The content of this framework has been agreed between the Department for the Economy and The Institute of the Motor Industry (IMI). This is the only Level 3 training in this skill acceptable for the receipt of ApprenticeshipsNI funding.

### 1.0 GENERAL

This framework specifies the standards and the criteria for the delivery of a Level 3 Apprenticeship framework to achieve qualified status within the Automotive Retail Industry. Successful completion of the framework will lead to the award of a VCQ Qualification at Level 3, VRQ qualification at Level 3, Essential Skills Certificate(s) and recognition as a qualified person within the industry sector.

### 2.0 PROVISION CONTENT

The Provision shall comprise of four main elements to be delivered in an integrated manner, not isolated subjects. Achievement of the VCQ qualification at Level 3 and the relevant VRQ qualification at Level 3 will be demonstrated by possession of Awarding Organisation certificates.
