

Level 3 Apprenticeship Framework Logistics Operations

The content of this framework has been agreed between the Department for the Economy and The Institute of the Motor Industry (IMI). This is the only Level 3 training in this skill acceptable for the receipt of ApprenticeshipsNI funding.

1.0 GENERAL

This framework specifies the standards and the criteria for the delivery of a Level 3 Apprenticeship training provision to achieve qualified status within the **Logistics industry**. Successful completion of the provision will lead to the award of a Level 3 qualification and recognition as a qualified person within the industry sector.
