

## **Assessment Requirements**

## **Unit PO07C – Demonstrating Competency in Establishing and rectification of Paint Defects**

**General Requirements** 

## You must:

- 1. produce evidence to show you meet all of the Learning Outcomes
- produce performance evidence resulting from work you have carried out on real vehicles in your normal workplace or as defined within the IMI VCQ Assessment Strategy as managed and organised by an approved centre when naturally occurring performance evidence does not occur at frequent intervals in your normal workplace or when safety is at risk.
- 3. be observed by an assessor as defined in the IMI VCQ Assessment Strategy.
- 4. produce evidence from your normal workplace of **establishing and rectifying** paint defects **from 4 out of the 8** listed below\*.
  - poor application
  - environmental conditions
  - contamination
  - corrosion
  - wear and tear
  - adverse chemical reactions
  - panel deformation
  - poor preparation.
- 5. be observed by your assessor on at least 2 different paint defects on separate occasions in your normal workplace.

\*However, you must prove to your assessor that you have the necessary knowledge and understanding to be able to perform competently in respect of **all categories of paint fault** listed above.
